OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Import of wireless equipments and exporting them back.

The competent authority has decided that for testing of imported wireless equipments, meant for exporting after assembling/ repair, for use in other countries may be allowed subject to the following conditions:

- i) Import of wireless equipments for re-export may be permitted irrespective of frequencies on which they can operate.
- ii) Such equipments may use frequencies under radiating/non-radiating conditions under Experimental License.
- iii) Experimental License shall permit as much power as necessary for testing/maintenance, while ensuring no harmful interference to duly licensed wireless networks.
- iv) As the equipments to be imported are meant for export, 'Type Approval Certificate' can be dispensed with.
- v) The importer shall self-certify that all the import equipments have been exported back.
- vi) WPC Wing may randomly verify the equipments/stocks of the equipments imported/exported. In case of any violation of the above guidelines/rules in force, relaxation so granted may be withdrawn along with the appropriate penal action.
